Notable Characteristics	<p>Thebe has a history of isolating itself from other nations. Until fifty years ago, this nation was a loose collection of principalities and duchies. As a nation, it has held a long policy of slow and stable expansion, either by absorbing new lands or by furthering development of already held lands to build this singular nation into an important, and increasingly modern power. Due to geographic boundaries, this nation has gone a long time without suffering an attack from a foreign power. The government in power has been ruling since their Quiet Revolution fifty-years ago. However, a small group has been reported stirring up trouble lately. This group, called the National Party, has been attempting to gain strength as an increasingly nationalist movement. They have promised to develop Thebe into a superpower on the world stage.</p>

Notable Characteristics	The Republic of Londe has focused heavily on developing its technology and its economy. This moderately-sized republic has grown greatly in the past two centuries by focusing heavily on avoiding armed conflicts when able and working through a system of trade to build a strong economy. The only nation they have had regular disputes with is their neighbor, Trastov. Thirty years ago, Trastov attempted a military invasion of Londenian land. The invasion was repelled, but the two nations have had tension ever since.

Notable Characteristics	Trastov is a massive nation and military powerhouse. General Kamra and his government have focused on military expansion of their territory for a long time. They have been a historically aggressive nation. While loyal to close allies, they are also fierce in the face of opposition. Many nations are concerned with the path that Trastov is heading down, but only time will tell.
